We are in the last strait line for the organisation of Nancy Met Soc 2009. So here are some important information concerning the practical organisation of the meeting:

- For people arriving at Nancy Central station: no transportation is needed because most hotels are at a walking distance from the station. In addition, the Faculty of Law where the conference will take place, is right at the City Centre, close to Stanislas Square and railway station.

- For people arriving at Lorraine TGV station: SNCF has set up a shuttle at each TGV arrival. Nevertheless, because of the limited number of places in the shuttle, we are planning to set up additional buses if a lot of attendees arrive at the same time.
